THE CLIMATE PARTNERS

NETWORK fosters cooperation to reduce emissions that affect the climate as well as to make companies more climate smart. The companies that join Climate Partners sign the Climate Commitment together with the Mayor of Helsinki. Each company specifies its own environmental goals. The goals aim at improving the current situation and outweighs the current legislation.

Examples of the Climate Commitments:

- To convert all of our (15) oil-heated buildings to using geothermal heating systems by 2020, CGI AVAIN Yhtiöt
- Renewable energy will account for over 60% of the VR Group's total energy consumption by 2020, VR
- Over 80% of personnel commutes will be conducted using public transport, Bionova
- By 2017 we will have the ability to produce NEXBTL diesel from raw material consisting of 100% waste and leftovers, Neste Oil Oyj,
- We will reduce our carbon dioxide emissions by 20% (100 RTK) compared to the 2009 level by 2017, Finnair
- To install a device-based information service point providing information about properties' updated data (energy, water and waste) in 70% of the properties by 2018, Lähi-Tapiola
- To increase property energy efficiency by 20% compared to the current level by 2020 through the utilisation of properties' internal energy flows and the smart grid, SRV yhtiöt Oyj

- Established in 2012
- 53 partners in 2016 (Businesses, Universities, research institutions)
- Aim is to increase new and innovative ways of cooperation to reduce the emissions
- Coordinated by the City of Helsinki
